2021 Program

CDCurtain Up! is a performance-oriented team, whose main objective is to provide quality entertainment to the community through public events. These events include and are not limited to local performances in commercial settings and local festivals. Training and rehearsals take place in Summer 2021, and performances will be scheduled throughout Fall 2021. CDCurtain Up is considered one of the Specialty Teams of CDC, and is supported by the Institute of Performing Arts for Youth (IPAYouth), a non-profit children's arts program in residence at Creative Dance Center.

The goal of the CDCurtain Up! program is to train diverse and adaptable performers, offering a positive and inclusive environment and opportunities for boys and girls to not only to excel both in technique on a dance level, but also through providing a versatile program which creates a well-rounded dancer and performer, through differing class genres and a range of performance venues. We have a group for adults, too!!! Dance styles may include Hip Hop, Jazz, and Musical Theater.

Summer 2021 Training and Rehearsal Schedule:

- Dance Tech class: Tuesdays: (Choose 6 of these 8 weeks) June 22 – August 10, 2021 at CDC Ashburn.
 - Minis choose 4:30 – 5:30 Ballet/Jazz or 5:30-6:30 Jazz/Hip Hop
 - Juniors and Adaptive 6:30 – 8:00 Dance Tech
- Choreography and Rehearsals: Thursdays (attend at least 6 of these 8 weeks) June 24 – August 12, 2021 at CDC Ashburn. Time TBD???

Requirements:

- Attend at least 6 out of 8 weeks of summer Technique classes on Tuesdays and Rehearsals on Thursdays. (Not required for Adults.)
- Enroll in and attend any class at CDC for the entirety 2021-22 Dance Season. This could include a recital class, tech class, or membership on a competitive Team. The monthly tuition and associated fees for this class are not included in the CDCurtain Up fees.
- Attend mandatory rehearsal before each event, as final blocking will be set in the rehearsal.

Fall 2021 Dance Season Events: Tentative

- September: Taste of One Loudoun
- September: Grandparent's Day at Potomac Green
- September: Ashburn Village Fest

- October 9, 2021: SterlingFest (Sterling)
- October: Loudoun County International Festival (Leesburg)
- December: Holiday Open House at Potomac Green
- Other events, such as Centerville Day, Brambleton Festival, Dulles Town Center Summer Camp Expo (Feb. 2022) and Cherry Blossom Parade (Spring 2022) may be an option. Note; Additional fees may be incurred to participate in these additional performances.

CDCCurtain Up! Fees

Tuition...Minis: 3 payments of \$255.00

Tuition...Juniors and Unique Movers: 3 payments of \$275.00

Tuition...Adults: 3 payments of \$150.00 (Tech class not included)

Payments are due: June 20, July 20, and August 20, 2021

Tuition includes:

- (1) 1.0 hour dance class for Minis OR (1) 1.5 Hour Dance Tech Class for Juniors and Unique Movers (6 of 8 weeks during summer)
- Weekly Rehearsals (6 of 8 weeks during summer, plus pre-show run-throughs)
- Performance T-shirt (for Opening Number and Team recognition)
- Costume Rental (2 dances)
- CDCCurtain Up program Dues

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED FEES

- Registration fee: \$75.00 due upon submission of application
- Any applicable fees/tuition for studio classes during the 2021-22 dance season.

Additional Potential Costs

- Costume accessories (earrings, tights, etc)
- General dance attire (leotards, tights, dance shoes etc.)
- White shorts for opening number
- Optional: Spirit Wear/Uniform (the same uniform will be used by all CDC specialty teams, as needed.)
- Travel expenses, family entry tickets to event (if any). Example: some performances may require additional entry fees (for both performer and parents), such as the admission to the Loudoun United Game.
- Possible Spring events at additional cost: such as Dulles Town Center Summer Camp Expo (Feb. 2022) and Cherry Blossom Parade (Spring 2022).
